Dunloggin will be holding its G/T testing for the 2018-2019 school year on **Thursday, August 23rd** at **9:00 AM.** Testing will be over by 10:30 AM. This testing session is available to any student who is new to the county as well as those students who have not taken the G/T eligibility test within one calendar year.

If you are interested in having your child tested for G/T level courses, please e-mail Ms. Han at lois\_han@hcpss.org with your child's legal name, the school attended last year, and his/her grade for this school year by **Tuesday**, **August 21st**. An e-mail confirming that your request was received will be sent. In the email, you will receive more information about the test and results.

If your child is unable to attend this testing session, another testing session will be held within the first month of school.

## What to expect on the first day!

We'd like Dunloggin to be the first middle school to have 100% of the Family File information to be fully updated, so visit <a href="https://www.hcpss.org/connect/">HCPSS</a> Connect today and click submit on the final screen!
