# **MCAP (Formerly PARCC) Home Reports**

In the next couple of days, students will be coming home with their MCAP (formerly PARCC) Individual Student Report. The students' Individual Student Report for MCAP Reading and Math assessments will reflect the spring test administration. Both the MCAP score reports will provide you with a snapshot of your child's progress toward depth of knowledge of the Common Standards, grade-level expectations and where he or she excelled or needs more support.

This information, along with grades, teacher feedback and scores on other tests, will help give a more complete picture of how well your child is performing academically.

# **Emergency Operation Procedures**

We want to make you aware that DMS practiced a lockdown drill with students today. ### **Reminders:**

- Car Pool: Parents, we want to make sure all students are arriving to and from school safely. Please remember to adhere to the car pool guidelines and follow the attendant's directions when dropping your child off in the morning and picking them up in the afternoon.
- **Bus Riders:** This week we had a number of students forgetting their bus number and/or getting off at the wrong bus stop. Parents, please review with your child their bus number, pick-up and drop-off location. Safety is our number one priority.
- **Bikers/Walkers:** Students are not allowed to walk or ride their bikes through the parking lot, as that is a safety concern. When walking or riding a bike to and from school, students are to remain on the sidewalk for their safety.
- Lunch: Parents, for the safety of our students and staff, you cannot have a mobile food delivery service (Door Dash, Grub Hub, Uber Eats etc...) drop off lunch to the school for your child. Parents or guardians must come into the build to drop off a lunch. Thank you in advance for adhering to these guidelines.
