Message from the Principal:

Reminders:

- **Car Pool:** Parents, we want to make sure all students are arriving to and from school safely. Please remember to adhere to the car pool guidelines and follow the attendant's directions when dropping your child off in the morning and picking them up in the afternoon.
- **Bus Riders:** This week we had a number of students forgetting their bus number and/or getting off at the wrong bus stop. Parents, please review with your child their bus number, pick-up and drop-off location. Safety is our number one priority.
- **Bikers/Walkers:** Students are not allowed to walk or ride their bikes through the parking lot as that is a safety concern. When walking or riding a bike to and from school, students are to remain on the sidewalk for their safety.
- Lunch: Parents, for the safety of our students and staff, you cannot have a mobile food delivery service (Door Dash, Grub Hub, Uber Eats etc...) drop off lunch to the school for your child. Parents or guardians must come into the build to drop off a lunch. Thank you in advance for adhering to these guidelines.

Back to School Night (BTSN):

Join us on Thursday, September 12, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. for **Back to School Night**. Our evening will begin with a **Canvas Parent Information Session** from 5:00 to 6:00 p.m. in the media center. Parents will have an opportunity to ask questions and receive support on how to create an HCPSS Connect account, as well as other helpful tips and information on Canvas. This is a perfect time to update your Family File if you haven't already done so. Right now, 209, or 33%, of our families have not updated their Family File. Remember parents, students are unable to participate in field trips or other extracurricular activities if their Family File has not been completed. Please complete your Family File today. We want to reach 100% completion at **Back to School Night**...we can do it!

In preparation for BTSN, parents, please print a copy of your child's schedule from Synergy via HCPSS Connect. You can also check your child's agenda book for their daily class schedule. Family File

Please remember to update your contact information in Family File by logging into <u>HCPSS</u> <u>Connect</u>. This information must be updated annually even if you do not have any changes. You will still need to click through each screen and click submit at the end in order for your Family File to be considered complete. Emergency Operation Procedures

On September 3, 2019, the Dunloggin staff and students participated in an Emergency Evacuation Drill. The objectives of this exercise are to train students and school-based staff in emergency evacuation procedures and to familiarize the school-based staff with common life safety hazards. This drill is one of fourteen drills we will conduct this year with students and staff. Reinforcing safety is a top priority not only for DMS, but the entire Howard County Public School System as part of our Emergency Response Plan.

On September 13, 2019, we will practice our second scenario drill, which will be lockdown procedures. Your child may have questions about what to do during a lockdown. In advance of the drill, our staff will instruct students on what to do, to avoid any unnecessary anxiety or stress. We encourage you to review these procedures with your child by visiting the <u>School</u> <u>Safety and Security</u> link on the HCPSS website. Remind your child to listen to and follow directions during the drills.

After any emergency response drill, we encourage parents to talk to your child about the drill and let us know if they have any questions or concerns. Parents, you can also find more detailed information about the HCPSS <u>Emergency Response Plan</u> and the proactive actions used in times of emergencies on the HCPSS website. It is our goal to ensure DMS is a safe and healthy learning environment for all students and staff.

Car Pool Procedures:

Parents: Foryourstudent'ssafety and the safety of our staff, please follow the following procedures for morning drop off.

- Once buses have arrived, students must be dropped off at the stop sign.
- Cars in the carpool line should let students exit the vehicle in advance of reaching the actual stop sign.
- All students are asked to exit the vehicle on the side closest to the sidewalk to avoid being hit by oncoming traffic.

- Parents needing to park and enter the building should park in the paved parking area before the stop sign (to your right).
- If your child is traveling to school with a project, large instrument, etc. please arrive early or later for their drop off- and lastly, if there is a substitute driver, please tell that person about procedures.
