# Virtual Instruction Responsibilities, Expectations, and Best Practices

A successful virtual instruction program for the 2020-2021 school year requires <u>collaboration</u> and shared responsibilities among students, educators, and families.

#### Google Meet Expectations for Students and Parents/Guardians

To ensure a positive, productive, and enjoyable learning experience for all participants, it is important that all students and parents/guardians adhere to these <u>Google Meet Expectations</u>, which include online behaviors for students and privacy guidelines for parents.

#### **Student Participation Expectations**

One important difference this fall as compared to the spring Continuity of Learning program is that students are expected to take an active part in synchronous learning activities throughout each week. For example, students may be called on by their teachers to respond to a question or asked to share feedback by using the chat box. The use of the video camera will still be primarily optional for students but teachers may ask students to turn the video camera on for short periods of time in order to engage in an activity or assessment.

#### **Attendance and Grading**

Attendance will be taken daily and <u>more details</u> can be found on the website. Your child's grade level will determine when attendance will be taken and what constitutes being present. Changes to the HCPSS grading policy will be discussed at the September 10 Board of Education meeting. More information will be provided as it becomes available.

#### **Student Schedules**

Student schedules are available for <u>viewing in Synergy</u> and will be posted in Canvas on Saturday, September 5. Students must log-in using their HCPSS credentials to access their schedule in Canvas on Saturday, September 5. They will also need to use their HCPSS credentials when joining their daily meets.

## **Updated Information on Meals**

Starting Tuesday, September 5, students can come to DMS or any neighboring school (except Burleigh Manor MS) to pick up breakfast and lunch. Meals will be distributed to students on the blacktop behind the gymnasium. Meals will be served Monday through Friday from 8–9 a.m. and 10:45 a.m.–12:45 p.m. These are Grab-and-Go meals.

Meals will be provided at no cost to all students through December 31, 2020, subject to U.S. Department of Agriculture funding availability. The food services program during the 2020-2021 first semester (Sept. 8, 2020-Jan. 28, 2021) will consist of Grab-and-Go meals.
