- 1. Take a selfie (**see requirements)
- 2. Save it as a jpg or png file with your name and grade (ex. Smith_Mary_6.jpg)

 - **Requirements
- 1. Head and shoulders up (no hats or sunglasses, no hand gestures)
- 2. Only the student
- 3. Centered in middle of the frame
- 4. Natural background (no odd shadows)
- 5. Good lighting and focused (no filters and no black and white)

Deadline to Participate in the Digital Education Center 2021-2022 - BY MAY 5, 2021

HCPSS is planning for a full-time online option for students entering grades K-12 who wish to learn virtually for the 2021-2022 school year.
