MAP Testing

On Wednesday May 26th, students in grades 6-8 will take the Measured Academic Progress (MAP) Math Assessment. The data from the MAP assessment will help schools and teachers measure the student's academic progress. The MAP test does not affect grades, and the difficulty adjusts depending on how your child responds. It is normal for students to answer about half the questions correctly.
