HCPSS Attendance Policy



- 4 hours of school = a full day's attendance
- 2 hours of school = a half day's attendance
- A note must be sent in within 2 days of returning to school or the absence is considered unlawful.
- Religious obligation forms must be submitted 2 weeks prior to the absence.

All absent notes must be emailed to dmsabsence@hcpss.org

- Students are permitted up to 3
 discretionary days of absence
 each school year. Please
 submit an Extended
 Absence/Discretionary form
 no later than 2 weeks prior to
 requested date. Any days
 beyond the 3 days will be
 considered unlawful.
- Lawful absence = student can make up work and will receive credit
- Unlawful absence = student can make up work but will not receive credit.

Early Dismissal/ Tardy Policy

EARLY DISMISSAL

- If your child will be picked up early please send a note with them in the morning and come in and sign your child out of the building.
- Parent Identification will be required when signing out your child.

MS Technology Use - Revise Cell Phone and Device Policy

In accordance with <u>Policy 8080: Responsible Use of Technology.</u> <u>Digital Tool, and Social Media</u>, middle school students will no longer be able to use a personal technology device, i.e. cell phone, tablets, or e-readers, during non-instructional time, including but not limited to transitions between classes, lunch, recess, or in the bathrooms. When students enter the building cell phones and other electronic devices must be placed in their backpacks/purse, it should not be visible in the school building. This will eliminate cell phones or other devices being lost, stolen, or taken away for violation of Policy 8080.

DMS Cell Phone Expectations

We want our students to demonstrate Focus, Integrity, Respect, and Excellence (F.I.R.E) in everything they do while at DMS.

Students failing to comply with the policy will receive...

- 1st Offense Warning and asked to put cell phone/electronic device away not seen or heard.
- 2nd Offense Cell phone/electronic device will be turned in to the front office. Students will get back the cell phone/electronic device at the end of the day. Contact home and Incident Report completed by teacher.

- 3rd Offense Cell phone/electronic device will be turned in to administration. Parents will be notified by admin and parents must pick up the cell phone/device from school. Students will be assigned detention and must write a reflection. Incident report written by teacher.
- 4th Offense Cell phone/electronic device will be turned in to administration. Parents will be notified by admin. Parents must pick up cell phone/devices and the student is prohibited from bringing tot school for the duration of the year. Office referral written

This information will be shared with students during the first week, along with the DMS Behavioral Expectations and the <u>HCPSS</u> Students Code of Conduct.

Drop off Procedures in the Morning

Arrival is from 7:45-7:55 am. Dismissal will start at 2:45 pm.

Busses and staff only should go past the stop sign into the DMS parking lot from **7:15** am - **8:00** am

Car riders, please drive **SLOWLY** and **follow staff directions** once you drop your student off, staff will direct you to exit through the Northfield parking lot.



Student drop off area is in **Blue**. Please have your student prepared to exit the car along the sidewalk. Students are <u>NOT</u> to <u>exit onto the</u> <u>road</u>.

Do not wait until the stop sign to drop off your child.




